- Brought up in Torquay

- Started his career at 16 with Cartner Engineering, Harrow
- Returned to Devon after a year to work for STC in Paignton
- Completed a BTEC in Digital Electronics at South Devon College
- In his 17 years at STC/Nortel he Progressed from trainee Electromechanical Design Engineer to Real Time Embedded Software Engineer and then on to various Management and Senior Management roles
- On leaving Nortel he went on to head up a new division at WWG in Plymouth developing telecommunications test solutions
- In 2000 he was instrumental in starting up PipingHot Networks in Ashburton and continued to work on and off with PipingHot as it transitioned to Orthogon Systems before acquisition by Motorola. After the acquisition Mark took up the full time position of Director of Product Management
